## Outcome: Underage Drinking

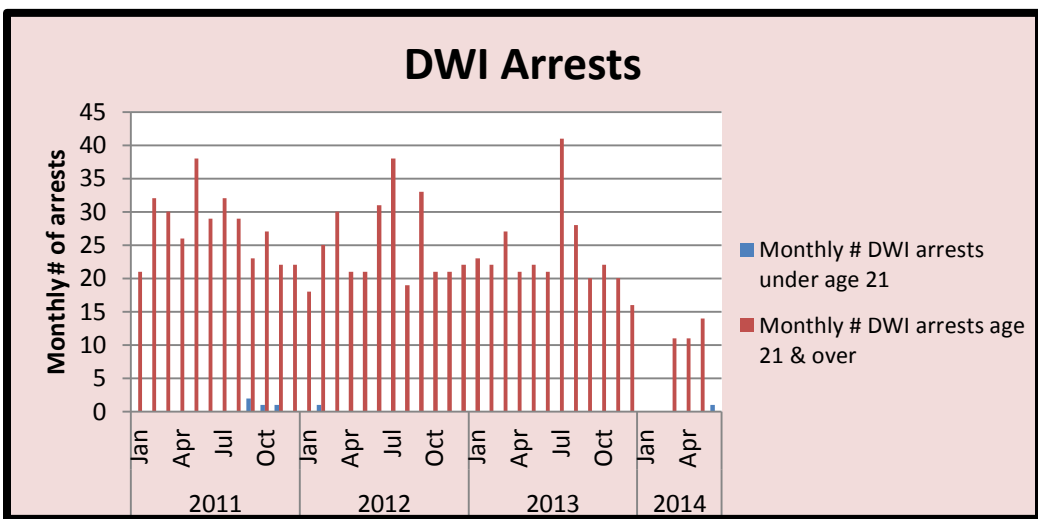
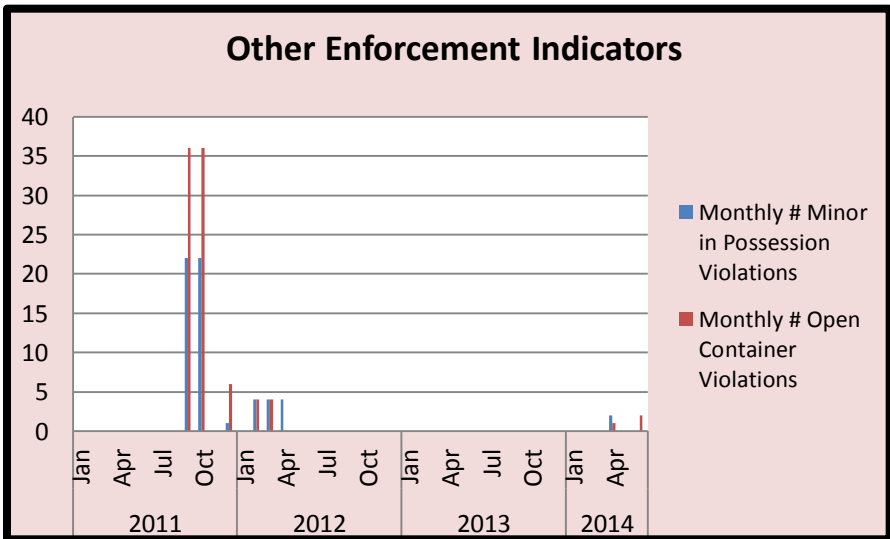
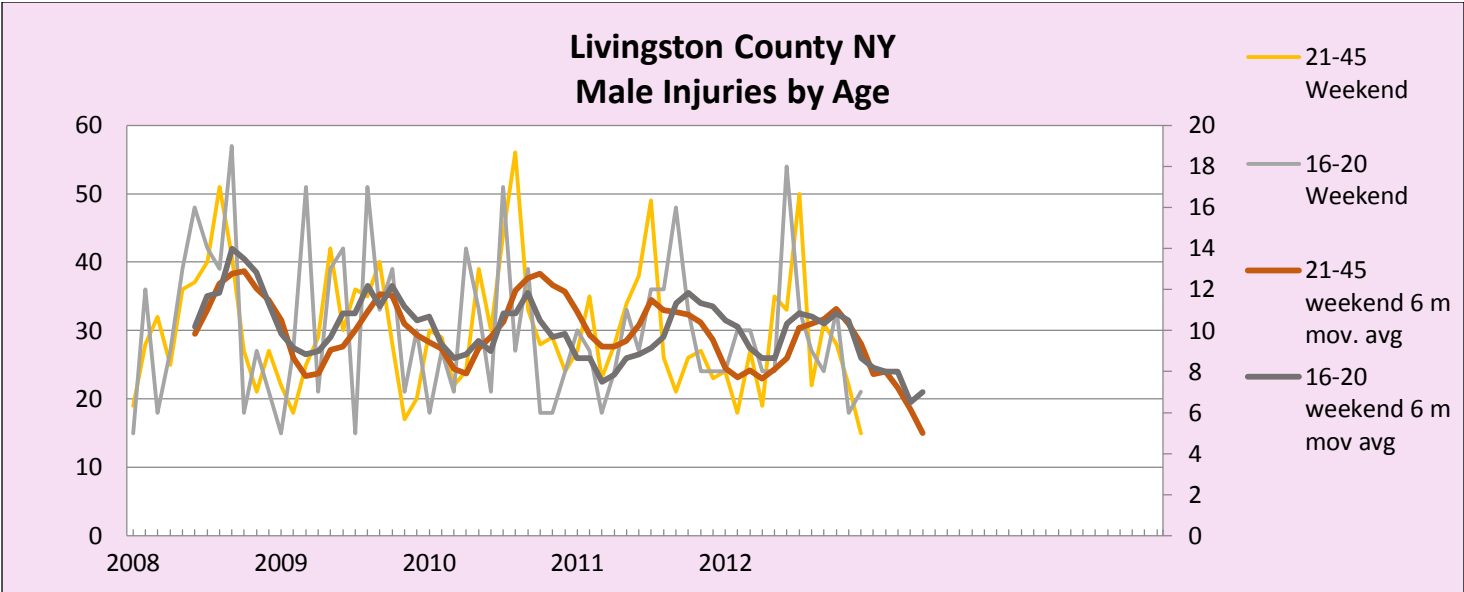

Overall past 30 day and binge drinking has decreased since 2004 with an increase from 2010 to 2012 for 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Brief survey conducted in May 2014 with mostly 10<sup>th</sup> grade students show lower past 30 day alcohol use and report binge drinking.

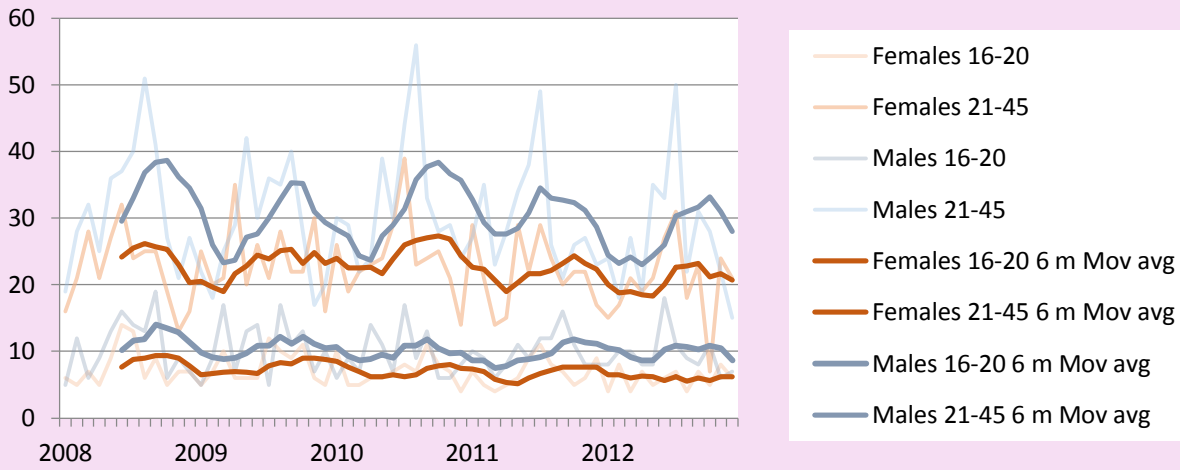


Weekend Injuries for males and teens/young adults have typically high alcohol involvement. No drinking and driving crash data yet available.

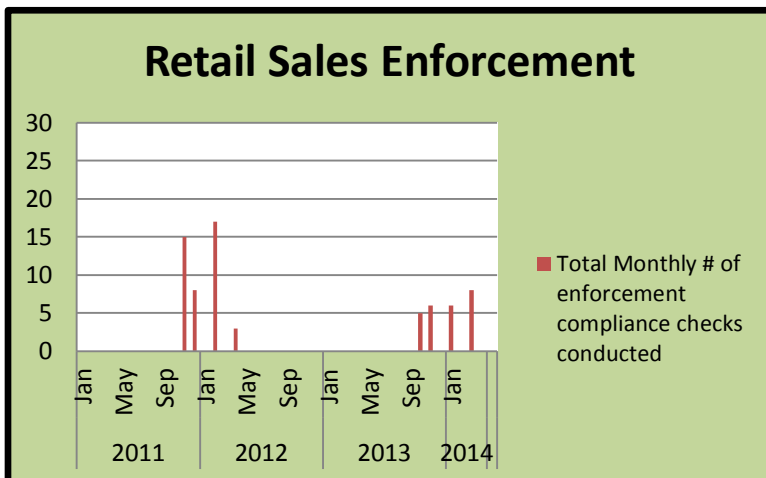
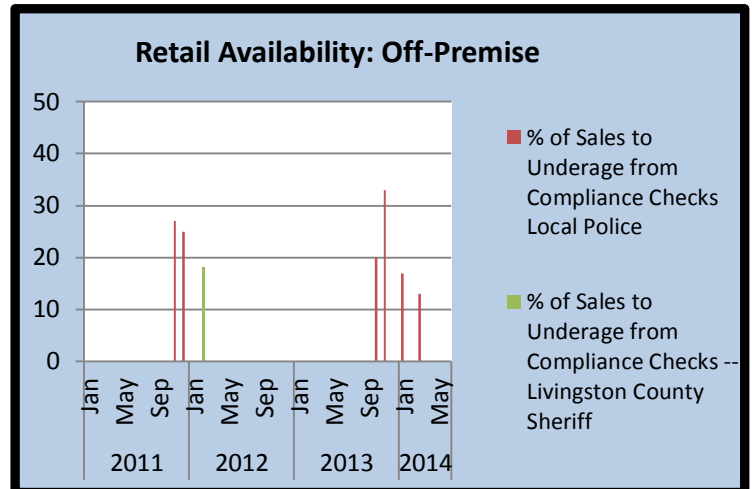
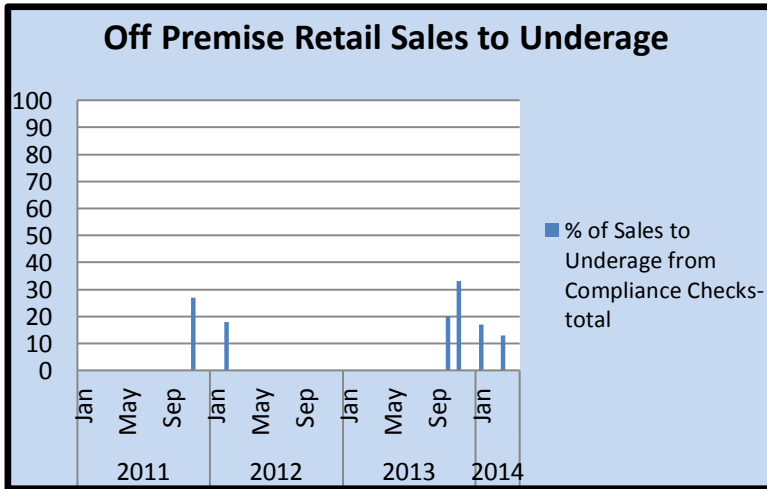
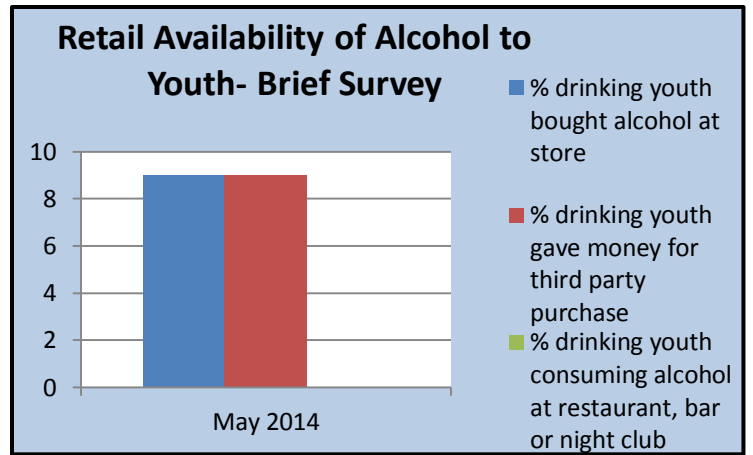
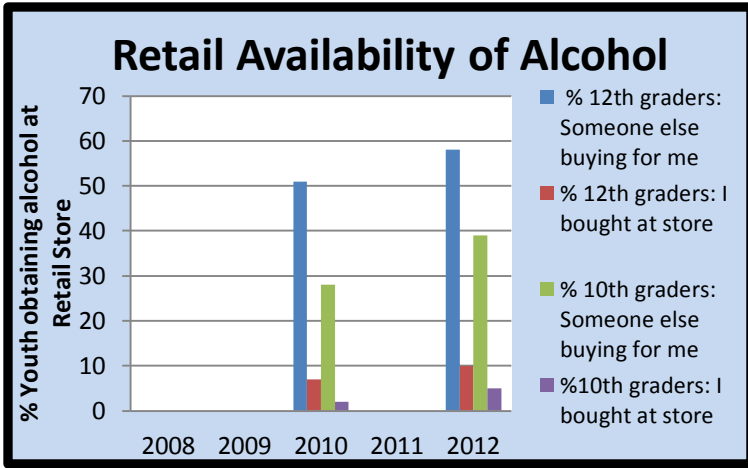


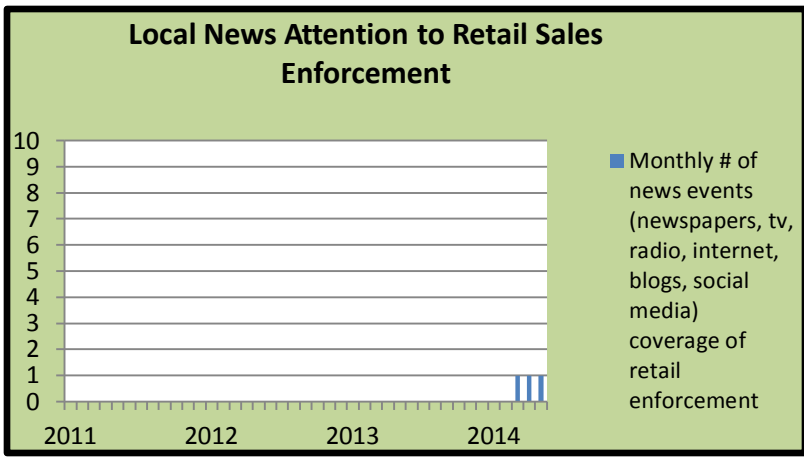
Minor in possession and open container violations peaked during our College Enforcing Underage Drinking Laws grant from 2011-2012.

## Livingston County NY Weekend Injuries by Gender & Age

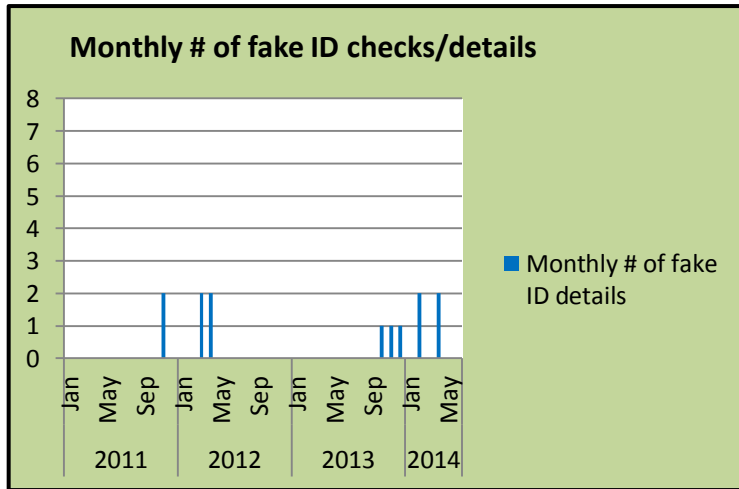
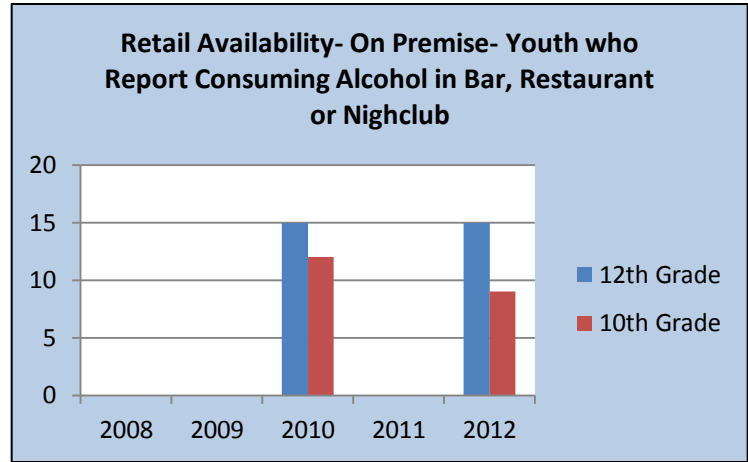
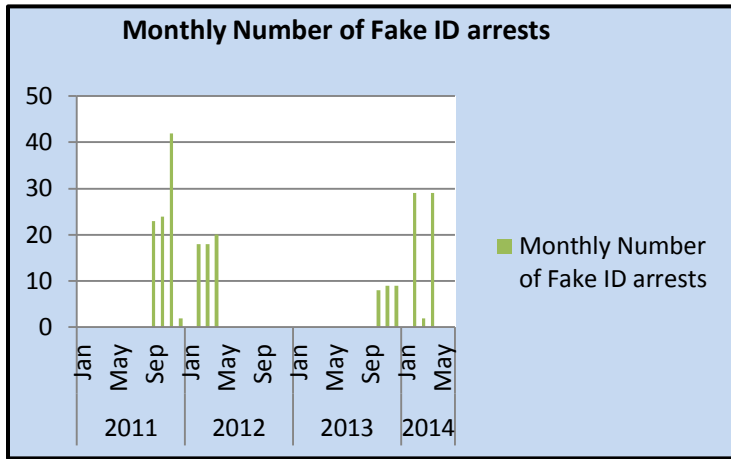


## Retail Availability of Alcohol to Underage Youth- Off Premise



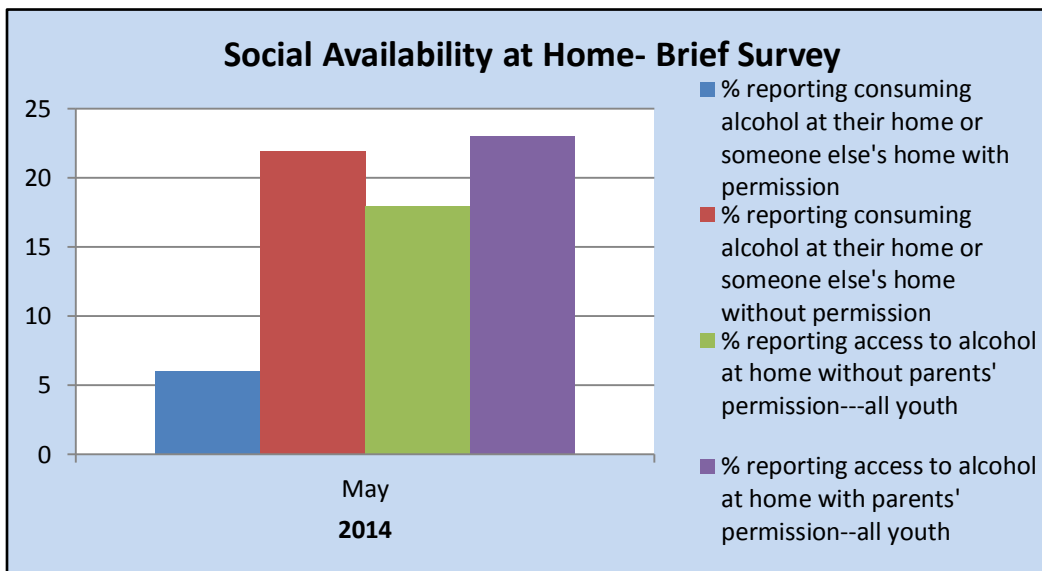
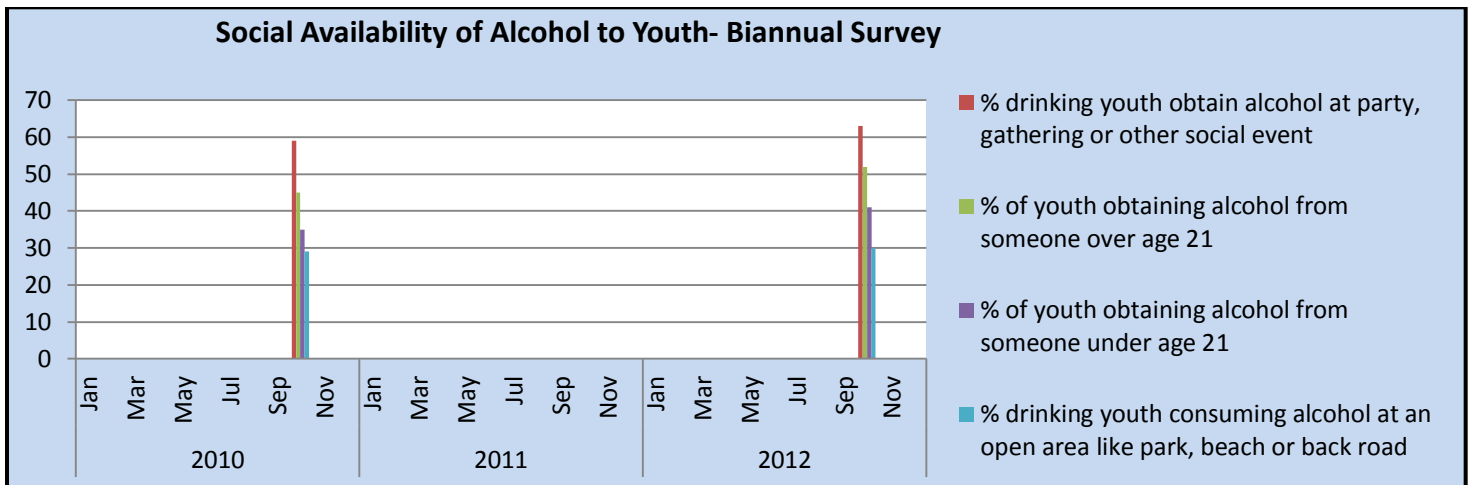
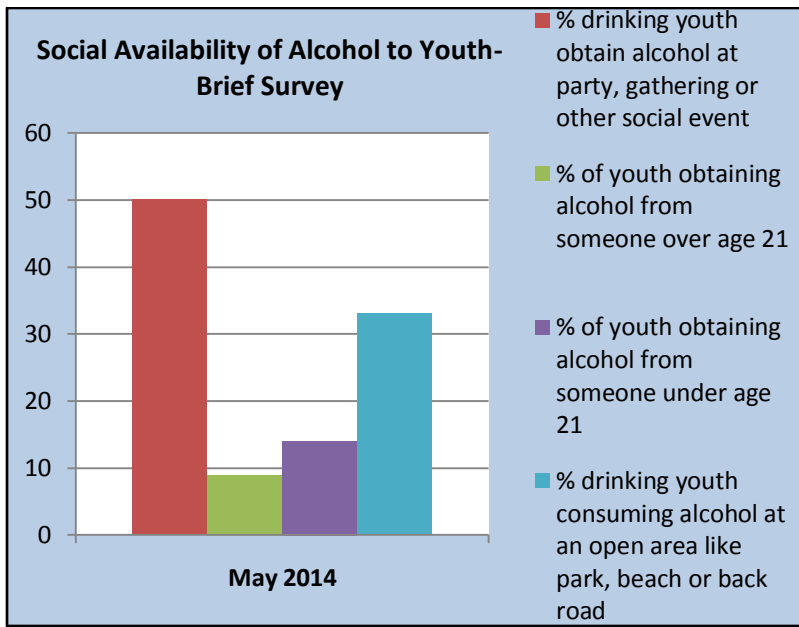


## Retail Availability of Alcohol to Underage Youth- On Premise

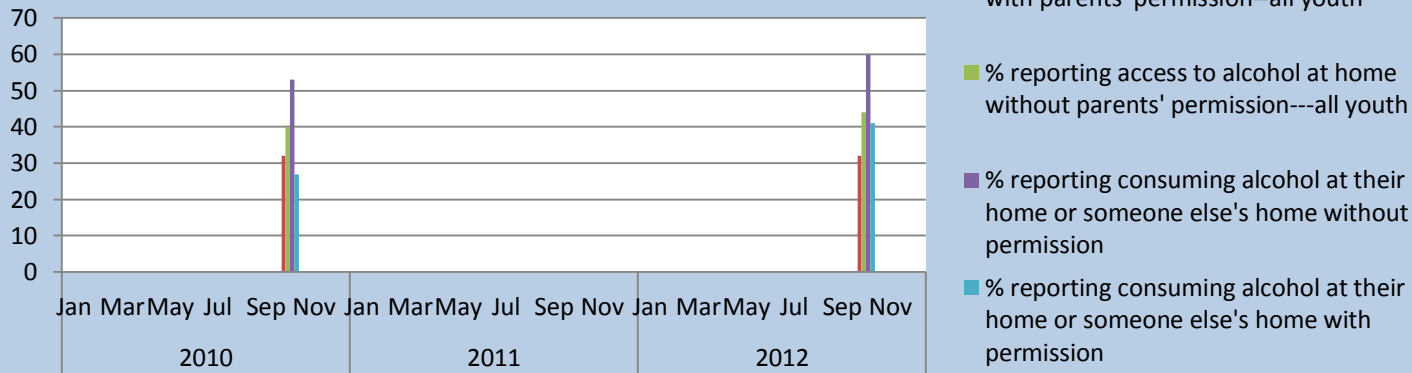


Fake ID details have been done through the Geneseo Police Department with DMV investigators outside Geneseo bars to locate underage youth using fake IDs to enter bars.

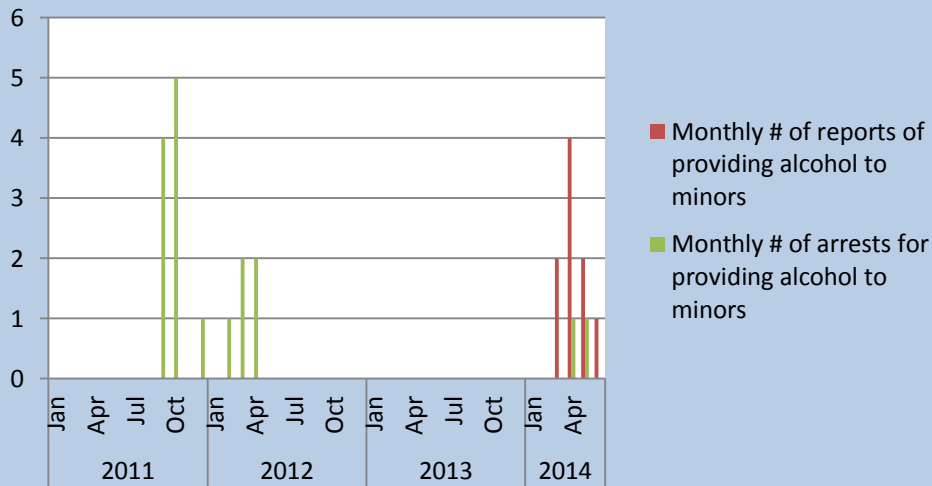

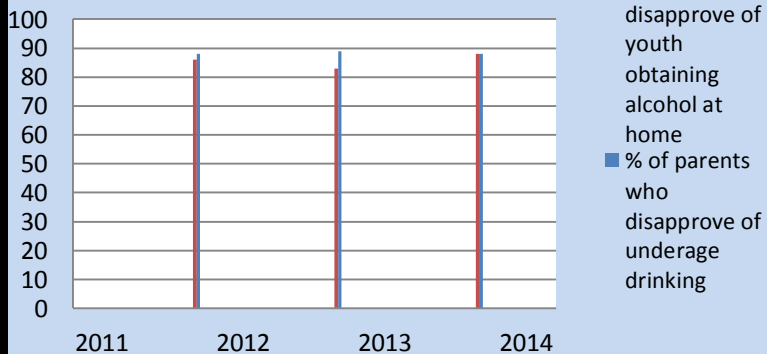
### Social Availability at Home- Biannual Survey



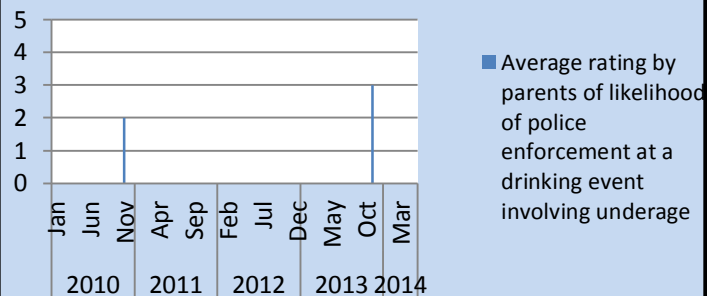

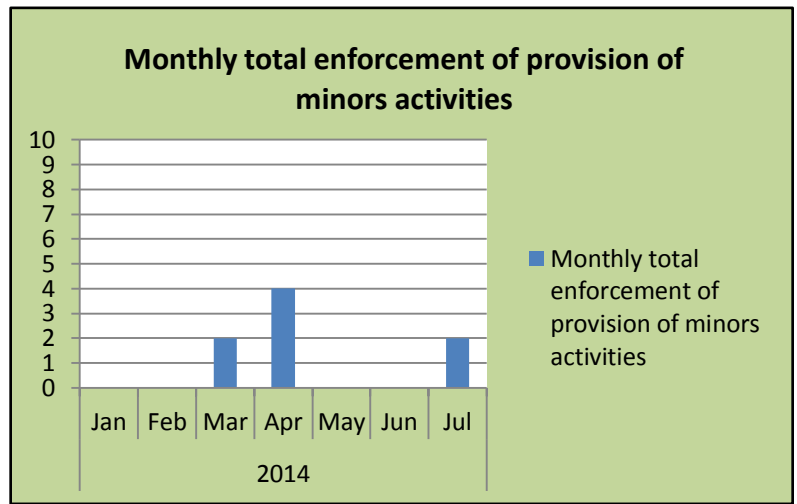
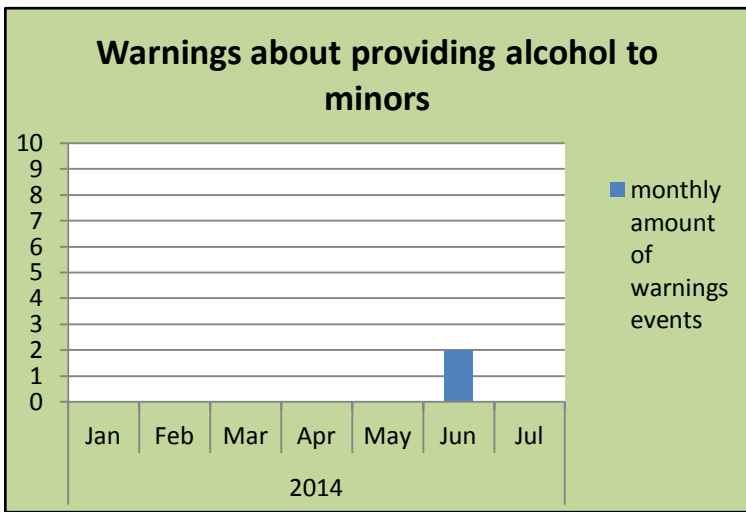
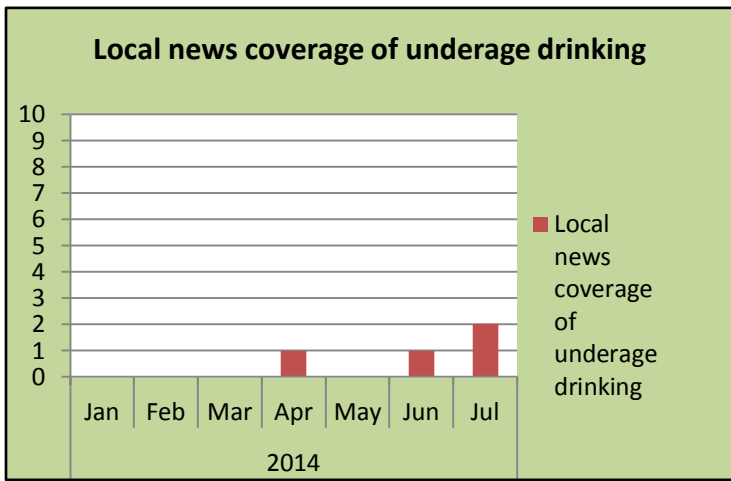
### Parental Attitudes about Underage Drinking



### Likelihood of police enforcement of underage drinking

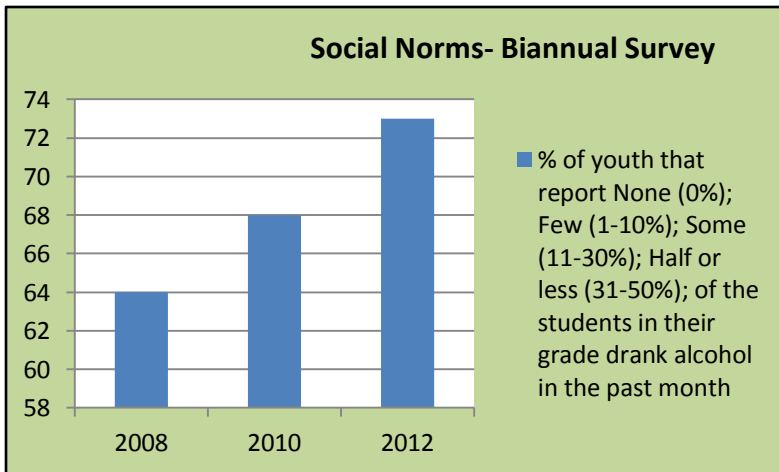
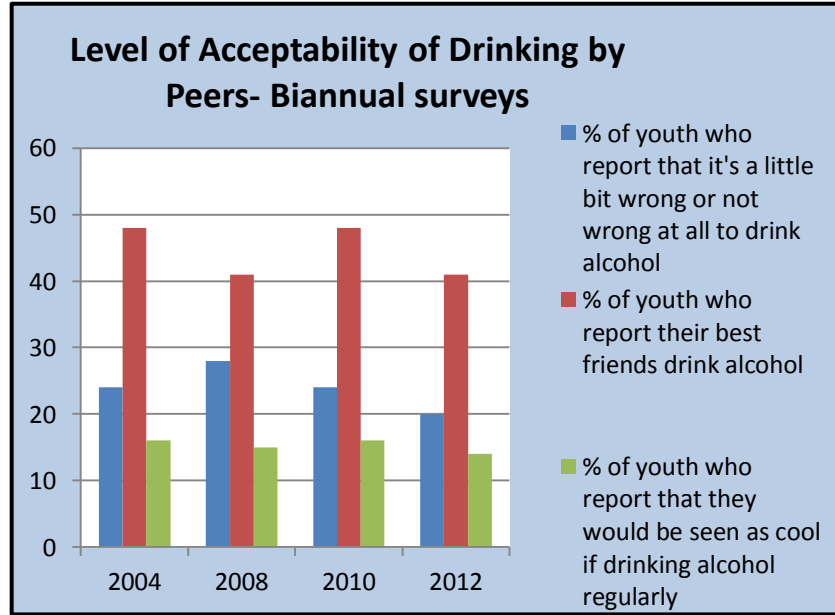
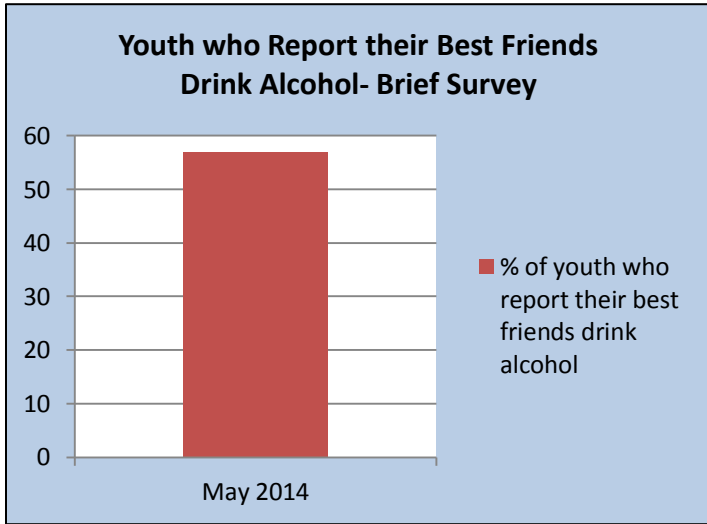


Rating on scale from 1-5 (very unlikely to very likely)
